ROLL CALL/ACCEPTANCE OF AGENDA

Nancy Irwin called the roll. A quorum was declared with 13 Trustees present. A revision to the agenda was made, regarding the addition of an item to discuss President Johnson's annual evaluation and extension of his contract.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Minutes of the 8-28-19 Personnel and Nominating Committee and Regular Session had been distributed. With no questions from the Board, Trustee Darrel Bobe made a motion to approve and Trustee Rick Schach seconded the motion. A roll call vote was taken, and there were 13 years and 0 nays, with the minutes passing unanimously.

PERSONNEL & NOMINATING COMMITTEE REPORT:

Election of Board Chair

Committee Chair Rick Schach reported that the Personnel & Nominating Committee had met and brought forth a recommendation to re-elect John Stachura as Chair for the Board of Trustees for another year.

Committee Chair Schach made the motion and Trustee Darrel Bobe seconded the motion. A roll call vote was taken with 12 yeas and 0 nays, with Chair Stachura abstaining from the vote.

CHAIRMAN'S REMARKS

Chair Stachura expressed appreciation for the Board's vote of confidence in re-electing him to another year of service as the Board Chair. He also commended Provost Treanor on the excellent letter she wrote to the Indiana Commission for Higher Education regarding an issue concerning Purdue University Global. He also expressed appreciation to Linda Waldroup for taking on the role of Vice President of Financial Services and thanked her for the great work she is doing. Chair Stachura shared that the Board completed an evaluation of President Johnson and have extended his contract for another year, through 2022. Trustee Mike Sievers spoke on behalf of the other trustees in expressing appreciation for President Johnson's work, especially in a year that has presented many challenges. He also stated the Board fully supports the work that the President is doing on behalf of Vincennes University. Trustee George Ridgway echoed Trustee Sievers' comments and expressed his full support of President Johnson.

MOTION #19-20

With no questions from the Board, Committee Chair Henderson made a motion to approve the curriculum items and Trustee Rick Schach seconded the motion. A roll call vote was taken with 13 yeas and 0 nays, with the motion passing unanimously.

Finance/Revenue Committee:

Bids for French Quarter Student Housing project

Committee Chair Mike Sievers reported that the Finance/Revenue Committee met on 10-4-19 to review and approve bids for the French Quarter Student Housing project. Chair Sievers asked Vice President Linda Waldroup to provide an overview of the project. VP Waldroup stated the first phase of the project is bounded by 1st and 2nd Streets, and from Hart Street to the railroad tracks, and reported the following bid information. It was also noted that funding for this project is coming out of University housing reserves.

Trustee Darrel Bobe expressed appreciation for the efforts and savings brought about by the re-bid process, and that local contractors are being used for this project. Trustee J.R. Gaylor asked about the process the University uses to advertise to bidders. Andrew Young, Director of Architectural Services & Facilities, explained the various sites, resources, and communications used to advertise to contractors.

Committee Chair Sievers reported the Finance/Revenue Committee has reviewed and approved the aforementioned bids and made a motion for the full Board to approve Contract #1 / Building #1 with Wolfe Construction, Vincennes, Indiana for \$1, 885,008.00 and Trustee George Ridgway seconded the motion. A roll call vote was taken with 13 yeas and 0 nays, with the motion passing unanimously.

Committee Chair Sievers made a motion to approve Contract # 2 / Building # 2 with Wolfe Construction, Vincennes, Indiana for \$1,984,917.00 and Trustee Tim Grove seconded the motion. A roll call vote was taken with 13 yeas and 0 nays, with the motion passing unanimously.

Committee Chair Sievers made a motion to approve Contract #3 / Building #3 with Wolfe Construction, Vincennes, Indiana for \$1,984,978.00 and Trustee George Ridgway seconded the motion. A roll call vote was taken with 13 yeas and 0 nays, with the motion passing unanimously.

Committee Chair Sievers made a motion to approve Contract #4 / Building #4 with Wolfe Construction, Vincennes, Indiana for \$1,096,481.00 and Trustee Reggie Henderson seconded the motion. A roll call vote was taken with 13 yeas and 0 nays, with the motion passing unanimously.

Committee Chair Sievers made a motion to approve the Site Construction bids with Kerns Excavating, Bicknell, Indiana for a total of \$1,141,450.00 and Trustee Darrel Bobe seconded the motion. A roll call vote was taken with 13 yeas and 0 nays, with the motion passing unanimously.

Committee Chair Sievers thanked VP Waldroup, Andrew Young, and Assistant Vice President/Budget Director Tim Eaton for all of their hard work and efforts on this important project for the University.

REPORTS FROM THE ADMINISTRATIVE LEADERSHIP

Recruitment/Enrollment Report

Heidi Whitehead, Director of Admissions, distributed the University Enrollment and Recruitment report. As of this report, which was approximately 11 days before the 10/15 reporting date, system wide enrollment was at 16,219 students. This

number is up from 15,784 students reported from the same point in time last year. As of October 4, incoming students on the Vincennes Campus reached 1,496 students, with 1,719 continuing students returning to campus. As of the same date, the Jasper Campus reported 227 incoming students, with 215 returning students. ASL and ATC reported 63 and 258 students respectively. The Admissions Office has completed many recruitment efforts for Fall 2020. As of this report, the Admissions team had attended 91 college fairs, hosted 12 application days, visited 114 high schools, completed 43 drop off visits, hosted 2 community events, and 10 other events. These efforts have helped to generate 963 accepted students for Fall 2020. The Housing Office had received approximately 1,200 applications as of day 1 of classes, with 35% of that number being returning students. Incoming student applications counts for Bachelor's Degree programs remained consistent compared to last year. As of the board meeting, the 4-year programs had the following application counts: Education Math - 3 Education Science – 3, Education/Special Education – 13, Homeland Security/Public Safety – 30, Nursing RN – BSN – 12, Technology – 13. Graduation counts for the 4-year programs have also remained consistent over a five-year comparison. For 2018/2019, Nursing RN-BSN graduated 50 students, Education/Special Education graduated 23, Homeland Security/Public Safety graduated 76, and Technology graduated 38.
