Definition of Subcohort: The "Revised 2005 Subcohort" represents first-time, full-time, degree/certificate-seeking students who were enrolled in "other than a Bachelor's degree" program in the fall of 2006 (Certificate or Associate Degree programs only). VU did not have any first-time, full-time, degree/certificate-seeking students enrolled in a Bachelor's degree program in this term.

*IPEDS classifies an institution by the highest level of degree awarded. Therefore, with the addition of select baccalaureate degrees, VU is now classified as a 4-year public institution offering primarily Associate degrees for Federal reporting purposes. Because of this classification, we are required to report using a 6-year cohort (Fall 2005) rather than a 3-year cohort (Fall 2008) for calculating graduation rates for completers within 150% of normal time to completion. Completions are broken down by the level of award conferred before calculation.

**The transfer-out rate was determined by merging the Fall 2005 cohort file to a file obtained from the National Student Clearinghouse. Data retrieved from the Clearinghouse is representative only of data they receive from participating schools; therefore, students in the cohort who transferred to a non-reporting institution are not reflected in the transfer-out rate reported.
