**Biographical or Historical Sketch:** Ernest P. Bicknell was born near Vincennes, Indiana, February 23, 1862. He died in September 1929. He served the Red Cross for twenty-seven years after an earlier career as a newspaperman and charity worker. As vice-chairman of the Red Cross he was in charge of insular and foreign operations. He directed relief work on such notable disasters as the San Francisco earthquake and fire, the Messina earthquake in Italy, Ohio and Mississippi floods and major mine disasters.
